

LIQUID NITROGEN THERAPY

You have just been treated with liquid nitrogen therapy, a very cold solution that superficially freezes the skin.

- 1. It is normal to have discomfort at the treatment site for 20 minutes or so after the procedure. You may also see some swelling that lasts 20 minutes as well.
- 2. Over the next 24-48 hours you will feel mild discomfort and experience swelling at the treatment site.
- 3. Occasionally a blister will form, it can be popped with a clean needle. Sometimes the blisters have blood in them.
- 4. Usually the area scabs over in a few days and becomes crusty. At this point, you can apply Vaseline to the area.
- 5. The whole process takes 7-10 days to heal.

Care of the treatment site is designed to be low maintenance. Please call the office at 508-226-0400, if you experience extreme pain or think the site may be infected.
